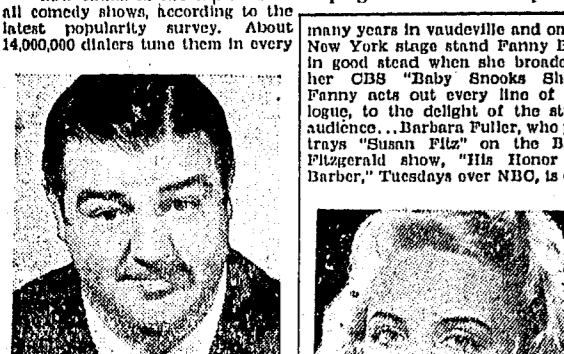






### RIGHT OUT OF THE AIR

### Large Number Re-Enlisting In Services

The total number of men enlisting and re-enlisting in the Regular Army now equals a figure greater than the Regular Army during the years prior to our participation in World War I. This figure is still short of that determined as necessary to fulfill our commitments with other nations for the Post-war Era. The large number of men who are either re-enlisting for further service or are making an original enlistment are eligible for the benefits offered by the Voluntary Recruitment Act of 1945, named by the public the "Red Apple Bill".

An analysis of the figures on enlistments that will result in 27% of this total number are former Regular Army men, 67.23% are men who had previous service in the Army of the United States only. These percentages are based on a total figure of 261,705 enlistments which were the result of Voluntary enlistment and until November 30, 1945. Of the total, 68,859 were for the three years term which gives the enlistee his choice of branch of service and over-seas duty.

The privileges still in effect are concerned with continuation of the family allotment, re-enlistment, although up to ninety days are given immediately upon re-entering the service, re-enlistment bonus up to \$300.00 full benefits under the GI Bill of Rights, foreign travel allowances, and retirement under either the 20 year or the 30 year plan.
