

# Hagaman Memorial Library Library Card Application

Any resident of East Haven, as defined by GS11-31a.(e) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, may obtain a Hagaman Memorial Library card.

Adults (18 and older) must present a photo id and proof of current address. The following, in order of preference, are acceptable forms of identification: CT driver's license, CT State photo ID, CT car registration, voter registration card, current telephone or utility bill, lease agreement or rent receipt, property deed, current tax receipt, checkbook with name and address imprint, student report, school schedule, or school ID. If a person has no photo ID or the address on the photo ID is not current, a second proof of residency will be required.

Students (age 14-17) must present one form of identification and proof of current address or be accompanied by a parent or guardian with proper valid ID as above. The following, in order of preference, are acceptable forms of identification: CT driver's license, school ID, student report card or school schedule.

Minors under age 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian with proper valid ID who will sign the application at the time of registration.

The borrower, or the parent/guardian signing the library card application for a minor, assumes full responsibility for all use made of the card. By signing the application forms, the borrower/parent/guardian agrees to comply with all library rules, regulations, and policies; to pay all fines; to be responsible for any loss or damage to materials; to provide immediate notice of any change of address; and to provide immediate notice if the card is stolen. As outlined in *The Hagaman Library Internet Use Policy* restriction of a child's access to the Internet is the responsibility of the parents or legal guardians. Therefore, the parent/guardian making application for a card on behalf of a minor child is responsible for allowing Internet access for the minor child and for setting any restrictions on the minor's Internet use.

Library cards are valid for three years. Patrons must present the full-sized library card (not the keychain card) and current proof of residency for renewal. Lost library cards are replaced at a cost of \$2.00.
