


Attention CT Writers!

What to Submit:

- Fiction and Nonfiction (3,500 words max)
- Poetry (2 poems max)
- Submit PDF files

Submission Details:

- Submissions will be open from February 1 until April 15, 2020.
- Authors must reside in the state of Connecticut by January 1, 2021.

Preparation:

 NOTE: Reading is blind, so the author's name should not appear on the manuscript. Please note if your submission is fiction, nonfiction or poetry on first page with title of work.

- Authors paid with one complimentary copy of the anthology, and featured in a public reading
