Stirling Davenport:



In a dark elven matriarchy many leagues underground, the ruling Nightwing's eldest daughter Tiala must save her people from her evil brother turned assassin.


In her search for champions in the dreaded Surface lands, a lot can go wrong, and her new cadres are an unpredictable lot with their own conflicts, desires and prejudices.

The Silver Reindeer:



Amphibious Dreamers:

This collection of stories by Stirling Davenport evolved over a period of 20 years. The tales are organized loosely by genre, although such designations can be ambiguous. Stories which appear at first to be fantasy are interwoven with reality. A gravedigger sees the ghost of a dead child. A man's obsession with memory leads him into a past life as a voodoo priest. An artist has a recurring experience with a homeless woman who may be his true muse.
